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The publication *LIKE THIS*. *Natural Intelligence As Seen by Art* brings together a series of specific commissions for der TANK, the exhibition space of the Institute Art Gender Nature, FHNW Academy of Art and Design in Basel: ten projects by internationally renowned artists Mathilde Rosier, Julieta Aranda, Cecilia Bengolea, Eduardo Navarro, Ingela Ihrman, Teresa Solar, Beatriz Santiago Muñoz, Raffaela Naldi Rossano, Alessandro De Francesco, and Gil Pellaton, presented at der TANK between 2016 and 2021. Conceived by Chus Martínez these commissions all share a common denominator: their interest in exploring all the possible dimensions of our relationship with nature. And they all share a common ally and friend in the [N.A!] Project and its founder Bertrand Jacoberger.

The [N.A!] Project initiative has always expressed an incredible confidence in the role and work of artists in conveying the possibility of establishing an equal relationship with nature. Consequently, its engagement with der TANK was almost immediate and facilitated a long series of artistic projects that serve two purposes: firstly, the transformation of the Institute Art Gender Nature's curricula, and secondly, the establishment of nature as the very substance that allows for an experience of life that makes us all responsible for the terms of coexistence, as well as the production of unique artworks that are slowly changing the perception and programs of the art system and its engagement with the natural world.

We have decided to publish this book, not as a closing chapter, but rather as an important piece of evidence to demonstrate how artists are teaching us to empathize with all forms of life, encouraging us to value what art and poetry have done to make us understand that intelligence is a shared trait, and that life can only be lived in mutuality, respect, and commonality.
